## CLASS SEMINAR ON TERRORISM IN NORTH-EAST INDIA

On 18/11/2020, Wednesday, the department of Political Science of Barbhag College organized a class seminar at the departmental honors classroom among the students of the department. The topic of this class seminar was "Terrorism in North-East India" and the resource person selected for this class seminar was Mr. HemantaDeka, HOD and Associate Professor of the Department of Political Science of Barbhag College.

Mr. Hemantadeka, in his speech, very actively expressed his opinion on the ongoing debate of terrorism and north-east India and how international terrorism is creating problems for the nation states and for the humanity itself. He was of the view that especially after the 9/11 incidents, international terrorism has emerged as a major challenge to human security. The states are facing serious security issues and are unable to provide security to its citizens.

Talking about the seminar topic, Mr. HemantaDeka, the resource person, elaborately discussed about the terrorist problems of North-East India. The terrorist activities of North-East India involve multiple armed separatist factions and possess a major threat to the security of the entire North-East India. This region shares a border with other countries and is marked by different issues of conflict, like ethnicity, tribal rivalry, migration, separatist tendencies that result in a very fragile security situation. Almost all the states of this region are facing serious security issues due to terrorism that disturb day-to-day life of the people in this region.

Keeping conformity with the programme, Mr. HemantaDeka also discussed about the factors which are responsible for the increasing terrorist activities like the role of the central government, financial issues, unemployment, separatist tendencies etc that need to be tackled to solve all the terrorist activities of North-East India.

In this class seminar, the Department also presented the papers of the teachers and the students in a positive note.



On 11/01/2021, Monday, a class seminar was organized by the department of Political Science of Barbhag College. The topic selected for the class seminar was "Debate on North-South Divide: Role of Third World Countries". Dr. Nandita Goswami, HOD and Assistant Professor of the Department of Economics of Barbhag College was invited as the resource person of the class seminar.

Dr. Nandita Goswami, in her thoughtful speech, clearly elaborated the meaning of the phrase "North-South Divide" in the international relations among the students. Dr. Goswami, clearly demarcated the 'north' and the 'south' as "rich countries" and the "poor countries", where the 'north' is taken to include the industrialized, high per capita income, national political economies of which most of the countries are situated in the northern hemisphere and the 'south' describes those countries with the high level of poverty and comparatively low level of industrialization, large number of which are situated in the southern hemisphere.


Focusing on the global north and global south divide in historical context, Dr. Nandita Goswami stressed on the dependency theory where colonial powers extracted resources from the colonial countries. Assuming the unequal relationships and exchanges between the north and the south, dependency theory calls upon for a delinking from northern institutions and for the launch of a self-centered development strategy which concentrate on the needs and demands of the domestic population. It demands for the establishment of a new international economic order for the better facilities of the global south.

Dr. Nandita Goswami also participated in an interactive session with the students. In this seminar, Nandita Patowary presented her paper on "North-South Divide: Role of India". Thus, with the presence of the faculty and students, the class seminar ended in an positive note.
