**The Proceedings in brief:**

The two days National Seminar was organised by the Department of History, Barbhag College scheduled on 21<sup>st</sup> & 22<sup>nd</sup> January 2022 and rescheduled due to Covid protocol which was held on 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> February, 2022 with the Title of *“August Kranti Movement and Its Multi Faceted Dimensions in Assam reflected in the Freedom Struggle of India”* sponsored by Indian Council of Historical Research (ICHR), New Delhi at the Barbhag College Premises.

India is now celebrating 75 years of its independence from the colonial regime. It is the time to commemorate the sacrifices of those martyrs and great soul as well those phases of hardship which could be the spirit of inspiration for the new generation. History is a preserver of the record and analysis of human civilization and freedom struggle is one of the

important phases that make the very existence of today's India as a Nation. Thus history has to keep those phases in its order for future generation as a spirit of inspiration.

Assam, an integral part of the Indian Nation has entered into the nationhood during the colonial period. It is situated in the north eastern borderline of the greater India geographically and has been touched by the colonial hegemony of the British somewhat lately by 1826. Having the connectivity of Assam with the greater India, it has been inspired by the each and every resistance endeavour of the Indian people against the British and the heroes of this corner of India also selflessly did engage, lead and sacrifice in all the sphere of the Freedom Movement.

This seminar has provided a platform to commemorate the martyrs of the Indian freedom movement with its multifaceted dimensions and locating August Kranti Movement particularly in Assam and placing it in the history of freedom struggle of India in general with a holistic approach of history writing. The seminar has given an opportunity to draw out the picture of the August Kranti Movement at the micro level and helps to find out unsung heroes of each and every corner of Assam. The impact and participation of Assam in the various facet of the movement that leads us to an inclusive history of freedom struggle and energize the new generation of each and every corner of India with the great legacy of martyrdom of their soil. The Book exhibition of ICHR, NERC that we invited and organised along with the seminar had helped in popularising the subject and successfully attracted the students in this sphere of knowledge.



Inaugural Ceremony

As the Inaugural Session started at 10 A.M. on Day one, the guest and participants of the seminar were welcome with a morning message by the Co-ordinator Dr. Namita Devi at the very beginning and then the seminar was started with the lightening of the lamp followed by an inaugural session. Dr. Birendra Deka, President of Governing Body and Dr. Birinchi Choudhury, Principal of Barbhag College lit the inaugural lamp along with all dignitaries present in the session with 'Deepa Stuti' performed by Dr. Namita Devi, Coordinator of the seminar. The Session was hosted by Dr. Anupam Dutta, IQAC Co-ordinator of Barbhag College. The Inaugural session was started by a patriotic song '*Viswa Bijay Na-Jwan*' performed by the students of Barbhag College and the lyrics of the song was written by renown laureate and freedom fighter Jyotiprasad Agarwala. The welcome address was given by Nivedita Goswami, Vice Principal of Barbhag College and in her address she highlighted the importance of the topic to the young generation. She also said that our nation not only having to face the external enemies but a lot of internal detractors as well. So knowing our nation with its strength and weaknesses, the study and research in historical facts are very important. In her speech, she highlighted the importance of August Kranti Movement which was a mass movement in the true sense against the British and mentioned that the participation of Assam in the phases of August Kranti where the Britisher's saw the might of the Assamese people. She also briefed up about the College and welcomed all the dignitaries and participants gathered for the seminar with a humble request to bear with the shortcomings of the institutional infrastructure. Dr. Sanjib Goswami, in his talk as Chief Guest discussed that "An important aspect of the Quit India movement was the way the movement was implemented. This was designed and implemented through various programmes in a pyramidal structure... The role of the subalterns and the protests of the marginalised and people in the fringes were ignored. Any activity that did not fall within the pyramid structure set up by the Congress was considered against the spirit of the movement. It is for this reason that any form of violence such as those relating to the Chauri-Chaura incident, the derailment of the train in Morigaon, the martyrdom of many in Assam including Kushal Konwar, Kanaklata Barua, Bhogeswari Phukanani, Rebati Lahon, Kahuli Devi and several others do not find mention in the national historical narratives of the Quit India movement. This therefore gives us further scope to research the neglect of events in the periphery like Assam or of those by the marginalised and subaltern people. As the Azadika Amrit Mahotsav is

being celebrated, this seminar should also research into a critical analysis of the Quit India movement in the light of international historical protests worldwide. The events in South Africa against apartheid, the Russian Revolution, the two nation resolution of the Muslim League in 1940, as well as the visit of Veer Savarkar to Assam in 1941, just prior to the Quit India movement are all events that hold much research potential and thus throws light on the multidimensional aspects of the Freedom Struggle in general and Quit India Movement in particular. Dr. Barnali Sarma, Associate Professor, Dept. of History, Gauhati University as a key note speaker highlighted about the importance of the phase and said that ‘as the seminar is on the August revolution we need to question what is so very specific of the movement. The seminar also attempts to probe into its multifaceted dimensions in Assam. So here I would like to set a pen picture of the time on which the scholars will address the different issues and of course with different perspectives in this two day seminar. Quit India or Bharat Choro are the simple but powerful slogan which launched this legendary struggle which we also call the August revolution. The quit India movement was started in a situation when Great Britain was engaged in a life and death struggle for its survival against the Axis power comprising Germany, Italy and Japan. Cripps mission who came with British war cabinets’ proposal on Indian question too failed as it did not carry any hope of independence after the end of the war. The situation in Assam was also critical as it was a frontier province. During this period it was in the grip of three terrible crisis- (1) the police repression consequent on launching the quit India Movement for freedom and independence (2) the economic and social dislocation caused by the imperial war effort coupled with the Japanese aggression and evacuees problem and (3) the famine problems and its impact on the life and activities of the people of the province. She also said that the Quit India movement though it did not bring independence in its immediate result, but it lowered the prestige of the colonial regime and shattered the so called invincibility of Great Britain’.



The First technical session of the seminar had begun after the inaugural session. The session was started with the moderation of Sanchyita Khakholar, Assistant Professor, Dept. of History, and Barbhag College. The chairperson to this session was Dr. Sanjib Goswami, Professor and Head of the Centre for North-East, Mahapurusha Srimanta Shankardeva Vishwavidyalaya and the resource person was Dr. Akunthita Barthakur, Associate Professor, Dept. of History, and Cotton State University.



Dr. Akunthita Barthakur as the resource person talked about the Assamese people and their sacrifices made during the Quit India Movement. The session had a total number of eight papers. The first paper was presented by Phulrenu Mishra, BBK College and the theme of the paper was “August Kranti Movement: Struggle and Sacrifices (with special reference

to Barpeta District). Again Barasha Barman, M.A. student of Gauhati University presented her paper on “People of Barnagar during Quit India Movement”. Then we have Jayshree Singha, presenting her paper on the topic, “August Kranti or Quit India Movement of Assam. The title of the other paper presented in this first session were “Contribution of Unsung Heroines of Quit India Movement 1942 from Darrang District of Assam”; ‘Gandhian Nationalist Movement and Raja Rao’s Kanthapura’;the Role played by the Student of Cotton College, Assam during the August Kranti’etc. The papers presented in this session has been highlighted and locate the participation of Assamese people of the micro level area of Assam in the August Kranti Movement and put forward the mass people representation in the Quit India Movement.



The Chairperson and the resource person gave their comments and advised the paper presenter. Dr. Goswami talked about how to write a good research paper and advised to follow research format in writing research paper. Dr. Barthakur pointing out the lacunas of each paper, advised the paper presenter to write a good research paper by following the proper methodology such as putting foot notes, references etc. The second technical session has begun after a short lunch break with the moderation of Monalisha Brahma, Assistant Professor, Dept. of History, and Barbhag College. Dr. Bhaskarjyoti Sarma, Associate professor, Anandaram Barua Institute of Language, Art and Culture, North Guwahati was the Chairperson of this session and the resource person was Dr. Akunthita Barthakur. This session had four research papers on different sub-themes related to Quit India and August Kranti Movement.



The first paper presenter was Pratyasha Takuldar, presenting her paper on “Role of language, literature and Culture in the August Kranti Movement with emphasis on Jyotiprasad Agarwala”. Dr. Jamaluddin Ahmed, Assistant Professor, Chamariya Anchalik College, presented a paper on “Role Language, Literature and Culture, in the Quit India Movement of Assam”. The next paper presenter was Rafat Subayyil who talked about the “Role of Mrityu Bahini , the death Squad of Assam. The Last paper of this session was “the Role of Tea tribes in Quit India Movement in Assam “ and was presented by Pranab Jyoti Phukan.



At the end of the Session, Chairperson Dr. Bhaskarjyoti Sarma analysing the whole session and put forward his observation on doing good research and urged the researcher to

do research narrowing the scope of the study. He advised that the presenter should be careful in selecting the theme; to narrow down the topic, again he said the researcher should be clean in the way that it may have impact for a longer period of time.



The second day of the National seminar began with 3<sup>rd</sup> technical session, which was moderated by Dr. Anupam Dutta Co-ordinator of IQAC, Barbhag College. The session was started with a speech of Dr. Kamal Nayan Patowary, Principal, Nalbari College on the role of August Kranti Movement in Historical Research.

A total number of five papers were presented in this session. Noopur Singh, Assistant Director, ICHR, New Delhi presented her lecture as one of the Resource person on “26th September, 1942 Remembering Unsung Heroes of Mrityu Bahini, Assam” through online mode. Then Bedika Bhattacharyee , Researcher of Gauhati University presented her paper on “August Kranti, Gandhian and the Rise of Feminist Nationalism in Assam”. Emphasising the ‘Role of unsung heroes’, Abdul Rouf and Tilak Sarma, presented their paper on “Sahidur Rahman: The First Assamese Martyr of Azad Hind Fauz”. Sumi Das on her paper highlighted the Role of Women in August Kranti. The last paper of this session was presented by Abu Shama Ahmed, Moriom Nessa and Abida Ahmed. The theme of their paper was “the Role of Assam in Historic Quit India Movement”.



At the end commenting on the papers presented, Chairperson Dr. Kamal Nayan Patowary indentified the scope of historical research in present day context. Resource person Dr. Rabin Sarma, Principal, Damdama College talked about history of the Freedom Struggle to be analysed from the Indian perspectives. Monalisha Brahama, Assistant Professor Dept. of History, has delivered vote of thanks in this 3<sup>rd</sup> technical session. After short tea Break of 15 minutes, the Valedictory session was started. This session was presided by Dr. Birinchi Choudhury, Pricipal Barbhag College, Nivedita Goswami, former Pricipal i/c and Vice Principal Barbhag College. The Session was hosted by Dr. Chandan Kalita, Assistant Professor, Dept. of English Barbhag College. The Valedictory lecture was given by Vice Principal Nivedita Goswami, where she highlighted the outcome of the seminar. She referred that the seminar has explored the history of Quit India Movement of Assam indicating the various aspects such as unsung heroes, local contributions, unsung heroes of Azad Hind Fauz and above all the involvement of women in a large and prominent scale in this phase of Freedom Struggle. The President of the Rapporteur Ajit kr. Sarma read out the Report of the two days Seminar and reviewed the outcome of the seminar as a whole and then certificates were distributed to the paper presenter. With the vote of Thanks given by Dr. Namita Devi, coordinator of the seminar and the Seminar had been closed down with the National Anthem by all the people of Valedictory Session.





A total number of 132 participants, teachers from different Colleges of Assam, participated in this online faculty development programme. Dr. Birinchi Choudhury, Principal, Barbhag College, was the chairperson of the organizing committee, while Dr. Anupam Dutta, Coordinator of IQAC, Barbhag College, was the Convenor, and Dr. Kishore Kalita was the coordinator of the programme.

**Day-1**

The webinar started with Dr. Choudhury delivering the welcome address at 11.00 a.m. The resource person for day-1, 26.06.22, was Dr. Sanjay Kr. Singh, Professor in the Dept. of Library and Information Science, Gauhati University. Dr. Singh gave a detailed presentation on the different MOOCs platforms including SWAYAM, and how to offer online courses on these platforms. Dr. Singh informed the participants that there are quite a few resourceful persons in the universities in Assam itself who can conduct training on designing online courses for MOOCs. Colleges can organize workshops and training programmes inviting these resourceful persons to train up the teachers.

The proceedings of Day-1 Concluded with Dr. Anupam Duatta giving the vote of thanks.

## Day-2

The proceedings day-2 began with Dr. Anupam Dutta, Coordinator, IQAC, Barbhag College. Welcoming the resource person Dr. Ritimoni Bordoloi, Asst. Prof., Indira Miri School of Education, Krishna Kanta Handique State Open. Dr. Bordoloi's presentation was a technical one, where she specifically explained how to design an online course. She demonstrated the technical details of designing an online course by means of an online course she has offered on SWAYAM. She went on to demonstrate module by module as to how a course for MOOCs can be designed just by learning a few technical things. She informed the participants that they can learn to design an online course by enrolling themselves in some short courses on the subject on MOOCs platform itself. Dr. Bordoloi, in her presentation showed how to begin the procedure of first planning the course, then applying for initial approval and then actually focusing on designing the course. She also explained the procedure of applying for getting approval for a course from a MOOCs platform, particularly SWAYAM, once it is designed.

The proceedings of Day-2 closed with Dr. Kishore Kalita giving the vote of thanks. The participants were mailed e-certificates of participation after the programme concluded.





Coordinator of IQAC Dr. Anupam Dutta gave the vote of thanks. The programme concluded at 2.30 p.m.







## **AY INTERDISCIPLINARY WORKSHOP ON ELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS (IPR)**

Organised By  
IQAC, Barbhag College  
Date: 10<sup>th</sup> January, 2022

Keeping in view the importance of Intellectual Property Rights, the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of Barbhag College has organised a one-day interdisciplinary workshop on Intellectual Property rights (IPR) on 10<sup>th</sup> January, 2022. The workshop was held by keeping in mind the restriction imposed by the district administration due to the outbreak of the third wave of COVID-19. Though limited in numbers, faculty of different colleges attended the workshop. At the beginning of the workshop, the Keynote address was given by Ajit Sarma, HOD, English Department of Barbhag College and the welcome address was given by Nivedita Goswami, Principal-in-charge of Barbhag College. Dr. Dhaneswar Baisya, Associate Professor of Political Science department chaired the sessions of the workshop.

The workshop was divided into two technical sessions. In the first session, Siddhartha Devnath, Scientist 'C', Patent Information Centre, Assam Science, Technology and Environment Council (ASTEC) was presented as the Special guest, who graced the occasion with his vast knowledge on the discussed topic of the workshop. The topic of his speech was "Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) and Patent". Describing Intellectual Property, he said that the intellectual properties are those things that are created in mind and expressed in some form or other. It must have the proof of ownership and should be recognised under the act of law. He cited the examples of light bulbs, pen, jewellery, etc as intellectual property. Elaborating ideas on intellectual rights, he also mentioned some forms of intellectual property, like inventions, designs, mark used in trade-brand name, mark used in goods to show its geographical origin, layout designs of integrated Circuit (IC), new varieties of plants, and literary, artistic, musical creation as well. He also talked about the rights enjoyed by people under intellectual property, like rights to enjoy the owner of an intellectual property, right to exploit, license, assign, surrender etc as the owner. Talking about the different types of intellectual property, he also mentioned the legislations enacted by the Government of India for maintaining intellectual property. Examples of such legislations are The Patent Act (1970), The Design Act (2000), The Trademark Act (1999), and The Geographical Indications of Goods (Registration and Protection act, 1999) etc that play key

role in maintaining intellectual property ownership. By imparting his knowledge on one of the major concepts of intellectual property i.e. “Copyright” he mentioned about patent and also about its significance for owners. He described patent as a legal grant of exclusive rights for an invention (product or process) provided by the government to the creator of a new and useful invention. Under the Patent Act of 1970, the inventor gets patent rights for a period of 20 years. He also elaborately discussed some criteria of patent, like novelty, inventive step, industrial applicability etc. In his speech, he also made a difference between the inventions that can be patented and those which cannot be patented. At the end, he talked about the different stages of patent from application to grant, fees and process of patent.

After a short break, the second session of the workshop began. Dipen Deka, Assistant Professor, Department of Library and Information Science of Gauhati University was the special guest in this session. The topic of his speech was “Copyright”. He discussed copyright mainly in relation to literary and fictional creations. To him, the copyright procedure in India is maintained by the Copyright Act of 1957. He mentioned that people can cite other’s works with proper acknowledgement and prior permission of the owner of the copyright for research or private study, for reporting current events and in connection with judicial proceedings. He identified the creators who are given copyright rights. Those are: a music composer, a film producer, a sound producer, a photographer and also an author who creates literary works. He also mentioned that copyright is also assignable for future work too. The term of copyright in literary works is 60 years and the performer’s right is 25 years. Again, he also talked about “Plagiarism” and what causes plagiarism and advised people the method how to avoid the fault of plagiarism.

A total of 40 participants from various colleges took part in this one-day workshop and made it a huge success.

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


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## Report on Webinar





A state level workshop on "Revised Assessment and Accreditation Framework of NAAC 2022" was organized by Nalbari Zone of Assam College Teachers' Association (ACTA) in collaboration with IQAC, Barbhag College in the Conference Hall of Barbhag College on the 11<sup>th</sup> of June, 2022. A total Number of 51 participants took part in the workshop. Prof.(Dr.) Utpal Sarma was the Resource Person in the workshop, which was chaired by Dr. Dhaneswar Kalita, President of Nalbari Zone of ACTA.

### Inaugural Session

The inaugural session started with the President of Barbhag College Governing Body lighting the ceremonial lamp at 10.30 a.m. It was followed by the welcome address delivered by Dr. Birinchi Choudhury, Principal of Barbhag College. Dr. Kamal Nayan Patowary, Principal of Nalbari College, Assam formally inaugurated the workshop. In his inaugural speech Dr. Patowary stressed on the fact that for an HEI to progress systematically and consistently, it is very important that the institution regularly keeps assessing itself and gets itself assessed by an external agency from time to time. He said that the role of NAAC in this respect is very crucial. For almost three decades now NAAC has been taking quality initiatives to uplift the HEIs qualitatively. It is necessary for each and every institution to keep itself abreast of the latest trends in quality culture in higher education. He congratulated ACTA and Barbhag College for having conceived this workshop on a very pertinent subject.

### Technical Session

The technical Session which started at 11.00 a.m., was chaired by Dr. Dhaneswar Kalita, President of Nalbari Zone of ACTA. Prof (Dr.) Utpal Sarma gave an elaborate presentation on the latest assessment and accreditation framework of Naac. Prof. Sarma, Who is the former Coordinator of IQAC, Gauhati University, explained every criterion in the SSR format issued by Naac on June 1, 2022. He showed how the SSR has to be prepared keeping in mind the strengths and weaknesses of an HEI. He said that it is

very important that each HEI prepares and submits the AQARs regularly so that the process of preparing the SSR becomes easier. He particularly emphasized the fact that smaller HEIs should exploit their strengths and utilize the minimal resources at their disposal to the optimum level. He drew the attention of the participants to certain critical key indicators which the HEIs have to focus on throughout a year in order to be able to make progress on those areas and thereby to uplift the quality of the institution. Prof. Sarma explained every key indicator and its importance in improving the overall quality of an institution. He also clearly explained the latest procedure of applying for assessment and accreditation by NAAC.

Following his presentation, Dr. Sarma handed out some questionnaire to the participants and asked them to fill up those questionnaire in order to see if the participants have actually understood the procedure of preparing the SSR clearing answering every key question under each key indicator in every criterion. The participants asked several questions regarding certain critical questions in some criteria. The participants particularly wanted to know how smaller HEIs score good marks with limited financial resources. Dr. Sarma made it clear that more financial resources do not mean higher grades. Even smaller HEIs can get good grades if they can make optimum utilization of the limited resources at their disposal.

The technical session ended at 1.45 p.m. with the chair making the concluding remarks where he requested the participants to share whatever they from the workshop with their colleagues in their respective institutions.

### **Valedictory Session**

The valedictory session started at 1.45 p.m. and was chaired by Dr. Dhaneswar Kalita, President, ACTA, Nalbari Zone. The secretary of Nalbari Zone, ACTA addressed the gathering. Some participants shared their views on the subject and lauded the organizers for organizing this workshop on this important topic. The Chair Dr. Dhaneswar Kalita summed up the proceedings of the workshop and thanked everyone associated with the workshop for their sincere cooperation.

The session ended after distribution of certificates of participation among the participants.



An online national webinar on AQAR & Its Impact on NAAC Assessment was held on 8<sup>th</sup> May, 2022. The webinar was conducted on Google Meet platform. Dr Jyoti Bansal, Director, Quality Assurance and Accreditation, Adamas University, West Bengal, addressed the webinar as the Resource Person. A total number of 160 participants from different colleges of Assam took part in the webinar.

The webinar began at 7.00 p.m. with Dr. Kishor Deka, Associate Prof. in the Dept. of English, B.B.K. College, Assam, delivering the welcome address. She told the participants and along with personal career development activities, departmental activities and other activities of the HEIs have to be regularly carried out regularly. For that each and every faculty member has to devote extra time. She said that it is important to introduce reforms and innovations in different aspects of an HEIs. Innovation, she said, is the key to development of an HEI.



Dr. Bansal said that NAAC has opened the portal for submission of pending AQAR since 2017-18 and HEIs can now submit all pending AQARs since 2017-18. Only if an HEI submits AQAR for the last five years, then only it will be eligible for assessment and accreditation.

The webinar concluded at 9.30 p.m. following Dr. Kishor Kr. Deka giving the vote of thanks.




### GUIDELINES TO FILL AQAR

- 1. All institutions have to submit #AQAR online in the prescribed format only.
- 2. Provide data for the previous year (or completed). Only one year's data needs to be provided in the AQAR.
- 3. Fill-in data templates have to be submitted online along with the AQAR with appropriate marks. Data templates along with supporting documents need to be uploaded in the mentioned website.
- 4. QAR responses need to be recorded as 100/100 marks only.
- 5. If an institution does not submit the AQAR online, it will be recorded as late submission.



