
## FRESHERS CUM LECTURE PROGRAMME

### House Sparrow Day celebration

Date: 20-03-2019

A lecture program was organised by the department of Zoology, Barbhag College on the occasion of "House Sparrow Day" at the college premise. The programme was inaugurated by Principal i/c Barbhag College, Unsur Rahman at 1:00 PM. In his inaugural speech, he laid importance of biodiversity conservation for sustenance of ecosystem and appealed to the students and concerned people to save house sparrow, because such birds are decreasing day by day from our environment. As a part of this programme a meeting was held. The meeting was presided over by Prativa Deka, HOD of Zoology, Barbhag College. In this programme the department of Zoology invited Secretary of Nature Club Barbhag College, Dr. Biplab Deka to give a speech on "Save House Sparrow" as a part of biodiversity conservation. He nicely explained the role of house sparrow in the food chain and also said that declining trend of house sparrow occurs due to unfriendly architecture of our homes, chemical fertilizers in our crops, noise pollution that disturbs acoustic ecology and noxious exhaust fumes from vehicles. He also mentioned that the house sparrow was declared Delhi's state bird in 2012. Through facing multiple threats, "the sparrow is categorised as a least concern" on the IUCN Red list-a species evaluated as not heading conservation attention. He discussed various conservation strategies and requested to all the students to take part in the conservation of house sparrow prevent the birds from extinction. In this programme many students and teachers of various departments of the college were present. At the end of the programme President Mrs. Prativa Deka, delivered her speech and she also emphasized on house sparrow conservation. The programme ended with a "vote of thanks" delivered by Dr. Rantu Mani Deka, Assistant Professor, Department of Zoology, Barbhag college.



### **“STUDENTS NEED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE POLITICAL SYSTEM”**

**DEPARTMENT OF POLITICAL SCIENCE**

**DATE: 05/12/2019**

On 05.12.2019, the department of Political Science organised a group discussion among the students of the department in the major room. The topic for the group discussion was “Students need to participate in the Political system”. Dr. Dhaneswar Baishya, Associate Professor of the Department of Political Science was present as the moderator of the group discussion programme along with the other faculty members.

The group discussion was held among three groups comprising the students of the department. The first group choose to speak in favour of the topic of discussion. The group highlighted the fact that the students from ancient time kept themselves engaged in politics, especially during reform movements. This involvement is in basically informal politics, like social movements, pressure groups etc. The group also put forwarded the view that students are the future nation-makers, who have more zeal towards the betterment of the society. They tend to more enthusiastic, energetic and flexible. They argued that India is one of the youngest democracies having 65% of its population below the 35 years. But the percentage of the young MPs is just 13% in the parliament, which is a drawback to the representativeness of the democracy. Policies affecting youth can be framed by young people themselves rather than old politicians, who most probably cannot feel the contemporary problems young people are facing. By making politics accessible to youth, the negative perceptions of politics can be slowly erased in the minds of young people. Therefore, the involvement of students in politics ensures inclusiveness. Another point added by this group that older politicians have to prove their loyalty to their political parties by supporting their authoritarian practices because of the long term commitment to their

parties. The students have advantage in this case, because for them, ideals and ideas dominate their commitment to the political parties.

The second group was against the topic of group discussion. They held that students tend to have idealistic and unrealistic visions for society, which may not be successful in implementation in the politics. They also lack experience because of which they become intolerant and unable to have realistic visions. For which, they can easily be manipulated and can be used as mere puppets in the hands of older politicians. This can be clearly seen in the violence and destruction of public properties by a few student groups. Another negative side highlighted by the group is that involvement of students in politics hampers their study also as students do not get sufficient time to devote in studies. This in long run affects their ability to get jobs or get them placed in profitable occupation. That is why; this group suggested that the students should stay away from politics for better prospects in life.

The third group presented their view about the participation of students in politics. They pointed out the hindrances on the way of students' participation in politics. They held that at present, Politics are not accessible to the common young people. Most of the young politicians of the present generation are from political families. Politics is not a career option in the present days and there is a strong negative feeling in the minds of people on politics that it is only for the corrupt. So, parents don't encourage their children to settle in it. In addition to this, there are economic constrains involved in the political participation of students as being active in politics doesn't ensure a regular pay check for them. Even if one chooses politics as a career, she/he has to wait for a really long time to get public support. Moreover, there is lack of political institutions. Students do not get incentives for political participation. Again, political participation may create threat to their life.

After listening to all the views put forwarded by the groups, the moderator and the other faculties of the department of Political Science came to the conclusion that:

- Political participation of students should be beyond the mere casting of vote. Young people must be involved in the process of elections as election observers, poll station workers etc.
- Students should be given the opportunity to do an internship in parliament.

- Political awareness should be given to the students of schools and universities and they should be encouraged to participate in politics.
- Student wings of the political parties need to be given more strength and priority.
- Skills trainings have to be provided to student politicians by experienced politicians.
- Political awareness campaigns must ensure that students are turning out in the elections to cast their vote.
- Student wings of the political parties have to be too transparent.
- Students led community development programs and volunteering organizations must be supported by the government.
- There is a need to form local level student councils.
- Student groups should be allowed to visit the national parliaments.
- Students' movements should be dealt in a respectable way and their voices need to be heard in the parliament.

## Report on Outreach programme by Barbhag College in rural schools

(12/03/2019-27/11/2019)



Barbhag College implemented a programme for the rural secondary school students in collaboration with Aryabhata Science centre, Nalbari during the year 2018-19 and 2019-20. The title of the programme was “Outreach programme by college in rural schools”. The programme was catalyzed and supported by Assam Science Technology and Environment Council (ASTEC) and Dept. of Science & Technology, Govt of Assam vide their sanction letter no ASTEC/ENV/1894/3489 dated 30/10/2018. The total programme cost was estimated as Rs 1, 45,000/- , out of which 1, 16,000/- was released by the sponsoring authority.

**Objective of the Programme:** The programme is intended to develop scientific temperament among the students of secondary schools and to create excitements in understanding science. As the infrastructure of most of the rural schools are not up to the mark, it is felt that intervention by the academic community at higher level may motivate the teachers and students in schools towards science and could make science more interesting .By involving college teachers in helping rural schools in deliberating science in a better and effective manner is the main target of this project.

**Activities under the programme:** For implementation of the programme 4nos of High Schools were selected under Barbhag Development Block and targeted the 10<sup>th</sup> standard students of these schools. The selected schools are Barbhag Kalag Higher Secondary School (Village-Kalag), Dakhin Barbhag Girls’ High School ( Village- Arangamow), Swahid Mukunda Kakati Vidyapith ( Village- Ranakucki) and Aitaru High School (Village- Kulhati).The major activities taken under the programme were as follows-

- Classroom teaching in the selected High Schools by the Science faculty of Barbhag College.
- Supply of few laboratory apparatus and chemicals to each science departments of the college for demonstration purposes.
- Demonstration of Laboratory equipments and experiments in Physics, Chemistry, Zoology and Botany Laboratory of Barbhag College by inviting the school students group wise.
- Organization of workshops among the students by the concerned schools.
- Distribution of small amount of financial assistance to the schools for academic activities.
- Issue of certificates to the resource person and students



The programme was formally inaugurated on 12/03/2019. Attending as the Guest of Honor in the inaugural function, Tanbee Hussain, Project scientist ASTEC expressed his heartiest gratitude to the Barbhag College family for taking such a fruitful programme and also appealed all the stakeholders of the programme to come forward for better implementation of the project. In the closing ceremony held on 27/11/2019, certificates were awarded to the participating students and resource person. Seven nos of science faculty from the college rendered their services as resource person and about 180 nos of students were benefited from the programme.



#### **Report of the Programme**


Today, the 3<sup>rd</sup> February 2010, an Interdisciplinary Teaching-Learning Programme on “Impact of British Imperialism on Indian society during the Pre-Independence Period” is organized by the Department of English, in collaboration with the department of Political Science and IQAC, Barbhag College. The programme is organized in the class room of English department and students of both the departments have participated in the programme. It is a two hour long programme consisting of a short lecture on the topic, followed by an interactive and brainstorming session. Mr. Niren Malakar, Associate Professor of Political Science Department has attended the programme as the resource person, and he is being assisted by Prof. Nivedita Goswami, Associate Professor, Department of English and Mr. Chandan Kalita, Assistant Professor, Department of English. The programme starts at 11 A.M., and altogether 45 students of all the semesters of both the departments and 4 teachers have attended the programme. At the very outset Mr. Chandan Kalita has explained the objectives of the programme and has focused on the interdisciplinary relevance of the topic. Mr. Chandan Kalita in his brief introductory speech elucidates the multifarious impact of British imperialism on the mindset of people of the Pre-Independence India, which in turn have influenced the very social nature and behavior of common Indian. Mr. Kalita has indicated that with the coming of the British, the English language has also gained popularity amongst the Indians and literary and other creative activities have started blooming in Indian-English language.

In his speech, Prof. Niren Malakar explains the very nature of imperialism focusing his interest on the impact of the British Imperialism on the socio-cultural and educational life of the contemporary Indian people. Mr. Malakar in his speech also points out that the British rule in India is held responsible for the modernization of the Indian education scenario and thereby modernizing Indian civilization to a great extent. He has given reference to Lord Curzon’s efforts in the 20th century that gave way to spreading higher education amongst the masses and channelizing Indian education system. Mr. Malakar also stressed on the fact that

during the British rule subsequent improvement is seen in the health standard of the Indians. He also pointed out that the average life expectancy of Indian people has also improved from 25 years to 35 years of age. Mr. Malakar has focused his discussion on the question of British Influence on the socio-political life of common masses and on the educational scenario of India influencing the creative sphere of literature and other art. After the speech by Mr. Malakar, an interactive session is conducted to answer some of the queries of the students on the theme and related aspects. Some students also share their knowledge on the political administration of the British, and have recounted the grass-root level socio-political and educational activities of the British. Before the close of the Programme a brainstorming session is conducted on the topic to make the programme more participative and fruitful.

Covid-19 pandemic was occurred in the 3<sup>rd</sup> week of January 2020. Gradually its intensity was increased and during 3<sup>rd</sup> week of March it reached a peak point. The government of India declared lockdown in the country for preventing the situation. In Assam also the Schools and Colleges were completely closed from 3<sup>rd</sup> week of March.

Covid- 19 is one of the most severe contagious diseases. Hand sanitizer is one of the effective and essential commodities to reduce the transmission of corona virus. The department of Chemistry Barbhag College took a bold initiative to prepare hand sanitizer in its departmental laboratory. 



Awareness Programme on **“Eradication Of Superstitions among Masses”**



The topic is "Future of STE: Impacts on Education, skills and work."


The aims of essay competition is to motivate the students to gain hands as on experience in the field of science.







### **Three day Workshop on Life Skill development**

**Organised By: IQAC, Barbhag College**

**Venue: Conference Hall, barbhad College**

**Date: 25-27<sup>th</sup> April, 2022**

The IQAC, Barbhag College has organized a three day workshop on “life skill development” on 25, 26 & 27<sup>th</sup> April 2022. The programme is organized in the conference Hall of Barbhag College. The main objective of organizing the programme is to impart to the students some knowledge on the importance of life skills and make them aware about the utility of these skills in an individual life. All together 65 participants including the students and faculty members have participated in the programme. At about 11.30 AM of 25<sup>th</sup> April, 2022. The workshop is formally inaugurated by Dr. Birinchi Choudhury, the principal of Barbhag College. In his speech Dr. Choudhury has explained how life skills help an individual in functioning well in different ways. He has also highlighted the benefits of life skills, how these skills aid in smooth adjustment social situations and regulation of self and emotions.

The inaugurated session of the workshop is also attended by the invited resource person namely Sri Basanta mazumdar, Sri. Biraj Kumar Sarma, and Sri. Alok mazumdar. The inaugurated session is concluded at about 12.30 pm.

The first technical session of the workshop is commenced at about 1.30 pm of the first day. The session is started with a brief speech by Mr. Basanta Mazumdar, one of the invited resource persons. In his speech Mr. Mazumdar explains that life-skills are actually the techniques that help in handling interpersonal relationships in a healthy manner. He added that these skills may be acquired through practicing on maintaining appropriate body language, and fearlessly facing crowds and speaking which will assist us while dealing with life’s issues and incidents. Mr. Mazumdar also stressed on the importance of “yoga and Pranayam” for improving the basic skills of an individual and subsequently his personality. As an expert in Yoga and Pranayam”, Mr. Mazumdar then conducted a demonstration programme on “Yoga and Pranayam” and trained the participants on some of the basic skills of these arts. The first day’s programme is concluded with some physical activities based on yoga principles.

The second day’s programme is commenced at about 11.00 am. The programme is started with a group discussion on some selected topics like public speaking, interpersonal communication developing appropriate body language, keeping the right attitude etc. these topics are given to different students groups to discuss and share their knowledge on the topics to each other. The students have fun time working as teams by brainstorming ideas. This technical session is guided by Mr. Bijoy Kr Sarma, one of the invited resource persons.

The second technical session of the day is commenced on 2.00 pm. In this session some of the participants present brief papers on some selected topics like- time management, emotional intelligence, the importance of creative thinking, learning from failures, maintaining body language etc. after the presentations of the papers an interactive session is conducted above some relevant interactive session is conducted above some relevant questions are taken for discussion- as some expert views/comments are also share for the benefits of the participants. At about 3.30, the proceeding of the second day is conducted.

On the third and last day of the workshop- two sessions are conducted. In the first session- a thorough discussion is held on the ten core life skills as listed by UNICEF, UNESCO-and WHO. These are: problem solving, critical thinking, effective communication skills, decision making, creative thinking, interpersonal relationship skills, soft awareness-building skills, empathy, and coping with stress and emotions.

In this session Mr. Alok Mazumdar, one of the resource persons, has anchored the discussions and the session is chaired by Dr. Dhaneswar Baishya, Associate professor, Dept. of Political science, Barbhag College. Some participants have also shared their views on the importance of the ten life skills.

At about 1.30 pm the concluding session of the workshop starts. The concluding session is chaired by Dr. Karuna Baruah, Vice Principal (Academic), barbhad College. Dr. Birinchi Choudhury, the principal, Barbhad College, has attended as chief guest. After brief speech by the chief guest, the certificates were distributed amongst. The participants Dr. bipul kalita has given the vote of thanks to all concerned. The workshop finally concluded at about 2.45 pm.

## Report of Socio Economic Survey of nearby villages

### Department of Economics

March, 2022

The students (five) of B.A. 3<sup>rd</sup> semester with Economics honours conducted a survey in March, 2022 on the Socio-Economic Condition in different aspects such as livelihood sources, saving behaviour, Consumption pattern etc of rural people of the nearby villages of the college in the supervision of Dr. Nandita Goswami and Gitanjali Goswami. The students found that the average monthly income of the rural families is Rs. 34800 which varies from Rs. 165000 to Rs. 9000 with coefficient of variation of 101.6 percent, but the average monthly expenditure of the families is Rs. 17945 and it varies from Rs. 6250 to Rs. 37350 with coefficient of variation of 46.8 percent. Thus there is wide variation in income among the rural families but the difference is relatively less for expenditure. The rural families spend a major portion of their expenditure for food followed by travel, clothing, fuel (LPG and electricity), TV and mobile recharge, education, health etc. On an average, the rural families save almost 31 percent of their income and they mostly save their deposits in banks (85 percent) and post office (15 percent). The occupational structure of the rural families is shown in the following table.

The table shows that the primary source of livelihood of 35 percent of the rural families is private sector job followed by Government job of 30 percent families. The secondary source of

livelihood of 40 percent families is also private job followed by daily wage of 35 percent families.

Moreover, one student of the said semester conducted her survey on the Self- Help groups of two villages of Barbhag area. She found five SHGs in villages Moura and Sonkuriha and each of them have ten members. Of these SHGs, three of are promoted by bank, one is by block and the other is self promoted. Three (60 percent) of these SHGs are engaged in economic activities like fish keeping, weaving and agricultural farming and the other two are engaged in accumulating savings of the members and in providing loans. The average annual profit of the SHGs engaging in economic activities is Rs. 29300.


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

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




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# **Report of Barbhag Book Fair**

## **Organized Jointly by Barbhag College, Sandhan (NGO) and Arya Bhatta Science Center, Nalbari**

**Date:** 16, 17, 18 and 19 November 2021

A state level book fair, namely “Barbhag Book Fair”, was organized with a four day long programme, and in collaboration with two renowned non-government social organizations of Nalbari district, namely Sandhan (NGO), Bangnabari, Nalbari and Arya Bhatta Science Center, Nalbari. The Book Fair was commenced with the hoisting the Book Fair Flag. Three other flags, of the three collaborating agencies, were also hoisted. The four flags were hoisted by four distinguished personalities. The main flag of the Book Fair was hoisted by Dr. Dhaneswar Baishya, the President of the Book Fair organizing committee. The other three flags hoisted were of the three organizing partners, including the flag of Barbhag College, hoisted by Mr. Nivedita Goswami, the Principal In-Charge of Barbhag College, the flag of Sandhan (NGO), which was being hoisted by Mirza Musaddikur Rahman, the president of Sandhan, and the flag of Arya Bhatta Science Center, which was being hoisted by Dr. Dinamoni Bhagawati, the president of Arya Bhatta Science Center, Nalbari district.

At about 10 AM a plantation Programme was conducted in the premises of Barbhag Kalag Higher Secondary School Campus and 10 no. of plant seedlings of different indigenous variety were planted by different invited guests including the present President of Barbhag College Governing Body Dr. Birendra Deka, the present Principal of BKHSS Mr. Makibur Rahman, the present Secretary of Barbhag Yuva Samaj Mr. Mahendra Sarma etc.

The debated competition was held in memory of Late Dipmani Bhuyan, who worked as an Assistant Professor of Barbhag College and a good player. 
