


2.3.1. Student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies are used for enhancing learning experiences using ICT tools

The College practices a teaching methodology which focuses on imparting education through a student centric approach. Teachers make classes as interactive as possible and encourage innovative thought and novel interpretations. Teacher uses methods like Google Classroom, Fieldwork, Project Presentation, Group Discussion, Debate on selected topics, Quiz based on syllabi, Essay Writings, Poster making, Play Short Drama, Knowledge based internal assessment, Regular Assignment, Laboratory experiments and analysis, Inter College Events etc. These means used by different departments help to provide experiential and participative learning. Annual festival of the college is also one of the important means to give opportunity to the students to participate in different events which give them knowledge by participation. Various competitive events like Drama, Dance, Songs, Debate, Extempore Speech, Quiz, Essay Writing, Rongoli, Spot Story Writing and different Sports events, Social Service, etc are organized in which a lot of students participate directly and indirectly and gather knowledge which are necessary for them for academic and day to day life. College Magazine which is published every year also gives opportunities to the students to get experiences of editing and publish their literary creativity.

There are three ICT enabled classrooms which are used by teachers for teaching-learning and for the competitions, specially quiz competition among the students. . The teachers use laptops, interactive boards, and projectors etc. for teaching in the digital classrooms. Audio Visual methods are used by the teachers during the quiz competitions. 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FIELD STUDY REPORT
ON
SOCIAL IMPACT OF BHANGRA GOHAIN THAN ON THE NEARBY VILLAGE
SONKURIHA
DEPARTMENT OF POLITICAL SCIENCE
BARBHAG COLLEGE


The department of Political Science, Barbhag College has conducted a field study on 24/04/2024 at Bhangra Gohain Than of Sonkuriha village. The objective of the study is to analyze the social impact of this religious place over the population of the village of Sonkuriha. The study was conducted by the department faculty and the students of Honours 2nd semester, 4th semester and 6th Semester of the department.

The Bhangra Gohain than is situated at the Sonkuriha Village, No.2 under the Barbhag Block of Nalbari District of Assam. The place of devotion and worship is believed to be emerged as a result of the pouring of the milk of a cow of a villager over the roots of a tree and then the eruption of the Shiva Linga. The place holds immense religious importance in the minds of people who regularly visit this place for worshipping. Historically, an annual Maha Bishnujagya is organized in this than. Again, Kali Puja, Mahashivaratri Puja are also celebrated in this than. Recently, the department of tourism of the Government of Assam, an office has been constructed in the than. Apart from being a religious place, the Bhangra Gohai than also has its importance as a place of social importance. The study is conducted to establish the social importance of this place around its neighboring area, mainly in the Sonkuriha village, No. 2.

The total population of this medium size Sonkuriha Village is 572 according to census, 2011. The village has a total number of 107 families. Out of the total population of 572, 287 are males and 285 are females. The literacy rate of this village is 96.37%. Under the Panchayati Raj Act of India, the village is administered by the Gaon Panchayat elected by the people. For the study, a sample of 20% is selected which includes 21 families. The students conducted interviews at the different households of the village and for that; they used the questionnaire method to arrive at the conclusion of the study.

After the analyzing the data received from the interviews, the study arrived at the following conclusions:

1. The place is the center of the people to discuss any social matter. The Gaon Panchayat and other people of the Sonkuriha village regularly hold meeting at the “Mukali Mancha” of the than to discuss social issues.
2. The children’s park which is constructed by the Tourism Department at this than also holds importance as children come and enjoy at this place.
3. It is also working for the development of Sanskrit language in the nearby areas. It has established a Sanskrit Tol for the study of Sanskrit language among students.


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4. The establishment of the office of the Tourism department at the than is another point of importance as the Department has been taking initiatives to improve the condition of this place.

Thus, the findings of the study show the social importance of this place. However, being an important religious and social institution, the place is neglected in terms of its security and safety. The pond at the place is not clean. The than lacks in proper fencing from all the sides. The children's park is also not properly maintained. Therefore, the proper maintenance of this place is highly recommended.


