<b>Proceeding of the programme</b>	<p>On 12/06/23, Monday, a faculty development programme was organised by the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC), Barbhag College. The one-day faculty-development programme was organised in order to familiarise the use of new ICT tools among the faculties to enrich their experience in teaching-learning process and also to benefit students. He mentioned during the time of the pandemic COVID, the video-conferencing apps helped both the teachers and students to continue the teaching-learning process. He, then requested Mr. Kulakesh Baruah, the speaker of the programme to start his speech.</p> <p>Mr. Kulakesh Baruah, in his speech, thanked all the participants and started his speech. He then introduced ICT Tools to all the participants and explained that ICT i.e. Information Communication technology helps in enhancing accessibility and promoting individual learning. By using ICT tools, students can progress at their own pace, receive targeted feedback, and engage with content that caters to their individual learning styles. It helps them foster a deeper understanding of subjects. Through digital literacy skills, teachers can develop a more conducive and better learning process, which in turn, makes learning more enjoyable and better understanding of complex concepts. The ICT Tools provide a wide variety of knowledge retention and the whole teaching-learning process become time-efficient, ease and more transparent.</p> <p>Mr. Kulakesh Baruah, then showed some ICT tools developed in recent time to the participants. He mentioned about the ICT tools like, blackboard, google classrooms, Trello, Cue think, Microsoft power-point, Edmodo, Quizizz and briefly explained about how these tools can be used. 

<b>Reports:</b>	<p>On 17/06/2023, the IQAC of Barbhag College organised an awareness programme on New Education Policy, 2020 to create awareness among the stakeholders regarding the education policy and how this new endeavour will impact upon the higher education institutions. The topic of the lecture programme was “Implementation of NEP 2020 In HEI Experiences and Challenges.” Dr. Ratul Mahanta, Associate Professor, Department of Economics of Gauhati University was invited as the resource person of the programme. Dr. Ratul Mahanta also works as a member of the NEP Implementation Committee, formed by Gauhati University to implement the new policy in all the levels of education curriculum.</p> <p>Dr. Ratul Mahanta, in his speech, mentioned that the Higher Education sector is undergoing a major transition in current times. The rising aspirations of the youth and the industry for work ready graduates are putting new demands on the teaching fraternity. The role of the teacher is envisaged to be more of a facilitator and mentor in developing well rounded individuals with skills to cater to the global needs of the 21st century of a more technology savvy and sustainable world order. The capacity building of teachers at all levels has thus been one of the major thrust areas in the field of higher education. Redesigning the higher education ecosystem as envisaged by NEP 2020 requires strengthening the role of the faculty. The Policy emphasizes the creation of motivated, energized, and capable faculty. NEP 2020 also envisions that pedagogy becomes learner-centered with mechanism for continuous, comprehensive evaluation and assessment of learners.</p> <p>Gauhati University will be implementing educational programmes structured under NEP-2020 from this Academic Session i.e. from 2023. It has been a quite a bit of challenge to roll out the NEP-enabled programme, especially with over more than 300 affiliated colleges ranging across the length and breadth of the State of Assam.</p> <p>Dr. Ratul Mahanta, then talked about the NEP implementation Programme under Gauhati University. He then mentioned that the flagship programme under NEP 2020 will be the Four-Year Undergraduate Programme, code named GU-FYUGP (or FYUGP), which is the four-year Bachelor's Degree programme with multiple entries and exits. This is being implemented in all affiliated colleges under Gauhati University as well as in the University Campus. With over more than 40 (forty) diverse subjects under the programme, this has been one of the biggest</p>



	<p>academic exercises, the university has carried out since the implementation of the semester system in undergraduate level. The policy promotes a flexible curriculum with multiple entry and exit points, allowing students to learn at their own pace.</p> <p>He then demonstrated the process of the NEP Scheme to be implemented under Gauhati University. He clearly differentiated the division between the core and the common courses, at the end of his speech, Dr. Ratul Mahanta also informed students about the ABC account and described about how they will be benefitted from this account.</p> <p>The resource person also participated in an interactive session with the faculties and students present in the programme.</p>
